Certification of the results of a study evaluating silicon content in biological materials depending on the consumption of Krondorf mineral water

The results demonstrated that the level of silicon in urine significantly increased after drinking one litre of Krondorf mineral water a day for two weeks. This suggests that **Krondorf mineral water** is an important source of silicon and contains silicon in a bioavailable form. The results will be published in *Klinická Biochemie*.
